

The Church Family in Worship

Think for a moment, of a holiday celebration as several generations gather around a large dining room table. All ages are represented, from the infant and the 2-year-old to the grandfather in poor health. It's a family gathering and a time of joy.

Different people will act differently during the day as they gather for the meal. From time to time the infant will squeal, and the toddler will squirm. A teenager might lapse into surly silence, and the elderly may fall asleep as they try to appear attentive. The family adjusts on the fly throughout the meal, making sure everyone gets what they want and what they need. That's how the family works: they bear with one another, respect one another and make sure that everyone gets fed.

The congregation of a Church is another way to think about the family of God as it gathers in worship to be fed. In His mercy and grace, the Lord provides forgiveness and life for all ages, for He died for all people no matter their birthday. By His Word and Sacraments, He provides grace and life for all during our times of worship; the goal being that everyone be fed, forgiven and transformed.

As with ordinary families, we are expected to bear with one another; respect one another (even when we disagree and need to be heard), and make sure that everyone gets fed. This, in my personal view is why Church congregations are so important – they show the world what Christian love, respect and forbearance look like no matter who we are, where we come from or how we feel today.

In the end, we are the family of God, gathered at the table of His presence and life. So, let us take care to nurture, support and protect each other as we dine together weekly at the Lord's' invitation. If we do not, then sin will insinuate itself into our lives and reduce us to our simple, natural selves in a world that is already dark enough and growing worse.

All of this simply highlights why we are gathered together: we are the family of God, dining, learning becoming because our Saviour came to bring us the forgiveness of sins – and will come again one day to see how we did.
