

Developing Generosity

All of us know about the financial needs of our churches these days. For many Christians, the days of hope and joy in the midst of church-centered activity and purpose have been replaced by a feeling of decline: of community; of shared ideas and of openness and accountability, one to another. Added to this, the apparent scarcity of generous people bearing the warmth of interpersonal regard seems to be leading us both as members of God's kingdom and as citizens of Canada into fear, doubt and uncertainty. And this is reflected in declining church attendance and resources.

This sad reality, I think, appears to have two effects. First, it paralyzes some of us and tempts us to act on our own understanding. This results in some of our church buildings looking more like community centers; places of entertainment and convenient locations for local groups to gather between Sundays — on payment of rent - simply so they can remain available for Sunday worship.

The second effect is the opposite. Scarcity and decline also encourage and even force us to try something new: to seek new opportunities for leadership and new applications of our spiritual gifts to build up the church and further establish the Kingdom of God. Hospitality. Helps, Administration, Music, Exhortation and Teaching, Prayer, Visitation, Meditation and exercising the Spiritual Disciplines are all ways Christians can overcome our fear of decline and replace it with a spirit of generosity.

Friends, we know that when there is a big project like a new roof to buy or someone's burned-out possessions require replacement that we can focus and see it to completion like the good stewards we are.

Developing Generosity (cont'd)

In the Church of Scotland, there is a new initiative called the Narrative of Generosity. It is a modular-based approach to teaching and developing the great biblical theme of stewardship through the use of stories aimed at developing the local church in our modern time. By engaging in this kind of activity, the Scottish Church believes that through our relationship with the God who loves us and whose church will never fail, has chosen us to be his stewards.

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. (Galatians 6:9)
